Schmick

Representatives Schmick, Kretz, and Warnick

Authorizes a county legislative authority to determine that a population of deleterious feral animals exists in the county and requires the authority to transmit that information to the director of the department of fish and wildlife. Requires the department of fish and wildlife, if notified of a population of deleterious feral animals, to develop and initiate the implementation of a management plan designed to eliminate or minimize the damage caused by the animals.

Senator Keiser

Requires a local government, in which there is planned to be a primary commercial service airport, to create an aviation protection zone. Requires the aviation division of the department of transportation to hire an independent consultant to identify the location of the next primary commercial service airport. This requirement expires July 1, 2011. Makes an appropriation.
