**Increasing state revenues**

**Hunter**

Representatives Hunter, Hasegawa, Ericks, Conway, and Springer

Addresses state revenue related to: (1) Minimum nexus standards; (2) Abusive tax avoidance transactions; (3) Placing a cap on the first mortgage deduction; (4) Direct seller business and occupation tax exemption; (5) Business and occupation tax preferences for manufacturers of products derived from certain agricultural products; (6) Eliminating tax preferences for bullion; (7) Ending the preferential business and occupation tax treatment received by directors of corporations; (8) Airplane excise tax; (9) Public utility tax on interstate hauls; (10) Foreclosure exemption; (11) Tax debts; and (12) Repealing the nonresident sales tax exemption, the sales and use tax exemption for livestock nutrient equipment and facilities, and the business and occupation tax credit for new employment for international service activities.

**Large commercial airports**

**Keiser**

Senator Keiser

Requires a local government, in which there is planned to be a primary commercial service airport, to create an aviation protection zone. Requires the aviation division of the department of transportation to hire an independent consultant to identify the location of the next primary commercial service airport. This requirement expires July 1, 2011. Makes an appropriation.

Prohibits the siting of incompatible uses, including housing, K-12 education facilities, and hospitals, adjacent to general aviation airports.

**SSB 6678**

**Aerospace industry**

**Hobbs**

Senate Economic Development, Trade & Innovation (originally sponsored by Senators Hobbs, Kilmer, Marr, Berkey, Tom, and Shin)

Creates the Washington state aerospace training and coordination institute to enhance the vitality of the aerospace industry by coordinating, providing, and developing curricula for a statewide consortium of schools and programs that provide aerospace workforce education and training. Creates the center for aerospace technology innovation to lead a collaborative effort between the state's universities, private industry, and government for the aerospace industry. Requires the University of Washington, Washington State University, and the department of commerce to work cooperatively with the private sector in the development and implementation of research and new technology. Provides a retail sales tax exemption to certain four-year institutions. Creates the Washington aerospace futures account. Makes an appropriation.

**SB 6843**

**Essential public services**

**Prentice**

Senators Prentice, Murray, Kohl-Welles, Regala, Fairley, Ranker, McDermott, Kline, and Keiser

Suspends the two-thirds vote requirement of the legislature for tax increases. Provides a means for the legislature to raise new revenue to fund voter-approved initiatives so existing education, public safety, health care, and safety net services for the elderly, disabled, and vulnerable people may be preserved.
