

Community Aviation Education Grant

WAMA has established a grant to assist in supporting education activities directed toward general members of the community. WAMA members may nominate or submit applications on behalf of organizations that provide aviation-related educational opportunities to the community. Purposes of the aviation education are at least two-fold:

- Enhance awareness on the part of the public of the value of the airport
- Increase knowledge of aviation among groups of young people

Community Aviation Education Guidelines and Criteria

The guidelines for the community education grant are quite broad and intended to allow applicants flexibility in supporting education activities. The Grant may be used to support special aviation education programs outside of a regular school schedule or to support programs or activities within elementary or secondary school. The grant funding level will be \$500 per year. That amount may be awarded to a single program or divided among two or more activities. The award will be made to the programs that:

- Reach largest numbers of people
- Reach areas of the State not previously served
- Address Aviation-related topics

The annual submission deadline is June 1. Late applications will not be considered. Applicants will be notified by July 1 of the outcome. Funds will be available after July 1. Recent successful applicants have brought the Museum of Flight programs to their airport or community event, utilized the programs offered by the Future of Flight Center and have partnered with other members of the Washington Aviation Coalition to support existing programs. The airport will be responsible for coordinating the event for which WAMA provides funding.
