 - HB 1198: Concerning the state commercial aviation coordinating commission.
 - Extends reporting deadlines and the work of the Commercial Aviation Coordinating 0 Commission (Commission) by two years.
 - SUCCESSFUL BILLS 0
 - HB 1379: Establishes the Unpiloted Aircraft System State Coordinator in the Aviation Division of the Washington State Department of Transportation.
 - Requires state registration of commercial unpiloted aircraft systems 0
 - 0 Exempts certain nonresidential aircraft and recreational drones from registering in Washington.

- SB 5031/HB 1030 Concerning A Community Aviation Revitalization Loan Program of CARB
 - o \$5 Million in Capital Budget
 - 0 2021 Update: Washington Action Plan FAA Policy Concerning Airport Revenues
- The Federal Aviation Administration's policy concerning the use of airport revenues requires that any state or local taxes on aviation fuel, except taxes in effect on December 30, 1987, be expended exclusively for airport purposes and aviation programs
- Aviation fuel tax, Hazardous Substance Tax (HST) & Petroleum Products Tax (PPT), and some State/Local use tax
- SB 2898 Contract Act Continuity for Operators with Necessary Training Required For Air Traffic Control Towers Act
 - Proposal to allow controllers who retire from federal service to work as controllers at contract tower airports without their federal annuity supplement being reduced or eliminated
